FFVA CONVENTION ATTENDEE LANDS HOLE-IN-ONE, WINS KUBOTA UTILITY VEHICLE

MAITLAND, Fla. (Sept. 23, 2011) – Don Brady of R.V. Johnson Insurance landed a big one to finish FFVA’s convention, and it wasn’t on the fishing excursion. Brady shot a hole-in-one on the 178-yard, par 3 second hole at Bear Lakes course in West Palm Beach. He walked away with a RTV 900XT Kubota utility vehicle provided by Florida Coast Equipment, a first-time sponsor this year.

It was the first hole-in-one in the tournament’s history. Amazingly, Brady said he also shot a hole-in-one on the same hole at Bear Lakes 25 years ago.

Brady said that when he hit the ball, he didn’t think he landed the shot. “I thought it went too far, because the ball just disappeared. I thought it rolled over the hill.” When witness Linda Lindenberg verified that it was indeed a hole in one, “I was shocked!” he said.

Brady said he has a home in the Keys where he might take the vehicle, although he wasn’t quite sure yet how he was going to get it there.
