

Fast Facts: Florida's Agricultural Trade

- Florida ranked 16th in the U.S. in agricultural exports in 2007
- Estimated value of agricultural exports: \$1.89 billion
- Exports represent 24% of agricultural revenue
- About 20% annual agricultural production is exported
- Ag exports support nearly 20,100 jobs (production, processing, storage, transportation)

Florida's U.S. ranking in exports:
